

Students of color will find a welcoming community of people that are historically under-represented in American culture on these campuses.


**Sample U.S. programs:** Consider studying at a historically Black institution like North Carolina A&T (North Carolina) or Morehouse College (Georgia). The University of North Carolina - Pembroke (North Carolina) and Fort Lewis College (Colorado) serve indigenous students. Texas A&M International (Texas) serves primarily Hispanic students.

## FOCUS ON CLASSES AND ACADEMICS

These large public universities offer wide-ranging academic programs, including the sciences, arts, English, business, and much more.

**Sample U.S. Programs:** Missouri State University (Missouri), Virginia Tech (Virginia), University of South Carolina Upstate (South Carolina), South Dakota State University (South Dakota), New Jersey Institute of Technology (New Jersey), Kent State University (Ohio).

## Application Process

- An ISEP student services officer that specializes in your preferred region will help you find programs that fit your needs and goals.
- Some programs have more space available and a higher chance of placement.
- You can list up to 10 programs on your application.

## UNDERSTANDING CHANCE OF PLACEMENT

Each ISEP Exchange site has a “Chance of Placement” based on the amount of exchange space available. Universities with a higher chance of placement send out more ISEP Exchange students, so they have more space available for inbound students. ISEP placements are made via an algorithm, and everyone who meets the eligibility requirements has an equal chance of being placed at a specific site. Learn more at the QR code to the left.
